

# COLUMBIA HEIGHTS IMAGES — Call for Art

**\*\*\* SUBMISSIONS DUE OCTOBER 1, 2018! \*\*\***

To celebrate the Columbia Heights Library's 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, there will be a photography exhibit in the Library's Community Room in December 1, 2018 for approximately six weeks. Amateur and professional photography, including cell phone photography, is eligible. There is no residency requirement. Photos must be taken IN Columbia Heights (other guidelines below).

Images will go through an art jurying process. Those who serve on the jury are prohibited from submitting. Electronic submissions will be professionally printed for cohesive look. Contributors will be recognized in the *Northeaster* newspaper, and receive the print of their image as a keepsake. There is no monetary prize.

Ownership of images: Artists retain ownership, but City of Columbia Heights receives permission to use the image in the exhibit and the exhibit's promotion, in the city's communications and publications with proper credit, and in future calls for art. *Northeaster* newspaper and other media may use the images in reporting about the exhibit, in print and online.

## SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

- There is no entry fee to participate!
- Open to residents and non-residents alike.
- Participants can enter up to 5 images *total*.
- Images must be of people, landmarks or activities in the public or quasi-public realm in Columbia Heights, and taken within the last 5 years. For example, not close-ups of flowers in a back yard or your pets in your home, but yes to overall landscapes in public parks, street celebrations, or people gathered on the street or in a church or school. If there are identifiable people in a photo taken in a non-public space, it is the photographer's responsibility to obtain permission to use the photo.
- Images can be in color or monochrome (black-and-white or sepia-tone)
- **THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS is October 1, 3:30 p.m.**
- No hard copy submissions will be accepted—only emails submitted to [Art@MyNortheaster.com](mailto:Art@MyNortheaster.com)
- If you do not have email or have trouble sending email, you may bring a thumb drive to the *Northeaster* office, 2844 Johnson St. NE, Minneapolis, MN 55418 weekdays between 8 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. in order to transfer your images. (After August 12, 2018)

### Submitting Your Images

Please INCLUDE:

- "CH Images" in the subject line, with your name as it will appear on the exhibit label
- Label each image with the title of the piece (for the exhibit label)
- Send only one image per email.
- In the body of the email: Your contact information and the general location where the photo was taken. You may also write up to 50-word explanations to go with each of your images. Titles and verbiage will not be considered in the judging, but may be included in the exhibit.
- Image files should be a minimum of 2000 pixels on the longest side up to about 3 MB in file size per image. Higher resolution (200 or 300 dpi) images provide the most flexibility in reproduction.
